2023-24

- 1. The tournament is open to all USBC Members. Non- Members may also qualify by paying Affiliated Membership Fees.
- 2. This is a multiple entry for both TEAM and Doubles. Not more than two bowlers on the same team can cash in the standings. Same two bowlers in doubles cannot cash in the standings more than once. When a bowler competes more than once in any event their first appearance in each event shall count toward their all events score, which is the total of their team and doubles scores.
- 3. This is a handicap tournament and all scores will be figured on the handicap. The handicap will be 80 of the difference between the individual average and 210.
- 4. Bowlers will use their highest BOOK average as of 2021. If the above does not apply then a bowler's average of 21 games or more as of tournament closing date, midnight March 14th, 2024 may be used. All others will bowl with a 200- scratch average. It shall be the responsibility of the bowler to verify the accuracy of the reported average on the form, whether submitted by the bowler, team Captain, or other. Failure to use proper average or make corrections prior to completion of the first game of the series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average therefore resulting in more handicap. If submitted average is higher, it will result in less handicap.
- 5. In case of a tie for first place co-champions will be declared. In case of ties for other positions the prize money will be divided equally.
- 6. All teams must consist of two (2) men and two (2) women. Doubles shall consist of one(l) man and one (1) woman. All events will be women in one standing and men in another standing. Substitutes will be allowed when necessary.
- 7. Entries will be scheduled according to request, if possible and in order received. The schedule will not be changed by the tournament director except in case of an emergency. Each event will be bowled on the assigned pair of lanes.
- 8. Any bowler or team arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl with the scores to count beginning in the frame being Bowled. NO SCORES WILL BE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.
- 9. Entry fee will be \$25.00 per person per event. Bowling fee \$9.00 for Lineage, \$12.50 prize fund, and \$3.50 expense fee . All events will be \$5.00 per person. All events is optional. No entry shall be valid unless accompanied by full entry fee and no entry will be returned after the closing date of midnight March 14th, 2024. The prize money in the team event will be returned 100 at a ratio of 1 for 10 entries. The prize money in the doubles will be returned 100 at a ratio of 1 for 10 entries. Ratio of prize money in the optional all events for both men and women will be at least 1 for 15 entries. Awards will be money for all places in the standings.
- 10. Prior tournament winnings need not be reported.
- 11. Bowlers for all shifts must check in at least 30 minutes before their scheduled bowling time and show their bowling cards.
- 12. Bowlers-will be allowed to keep their own scores and the print outs will be the official score. In case scores are lost due to computer failure or any other reason that is beyond our control while a game is in progress the game will be bowled over.
- 13. USBC Rule 319c through 31ge will apply to all Bowlers and the bowlers are cautioned to be aware of the re-rating rule.
- 14. NO CHILDREN or NON-BOWLERS will be allowed in the bowling area.
- 15. We will not contact you unless there is a problem with your Times and Date.
